Bounliem Mahathath, 77, of Perryville, Missouri passed away Saturday, May 4, 2024 at his residence.

He was born June 2, 1946 in Thakek, Laos to Ta Anthony and Mack (Muongsaveng) Mahathath.

He married Simmaly Peth, also from Laos. She survives him in Perryville.

Bounliem was a member of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church in Perryville.
