Dennis M. Lundstrom, 78, of Cape Girardeau, formerly of Perryville, passed away Friday, October 2, 2020 at Missouri Veterans Home in Cape Girardeau, MO.

He was born May 25, 1942 in St. Louis, MO to Drew and Jasmine Lundstrom. He and Jennifer Knigge were married in 1969. She preceded him in death on January 5, 2001. He and Reta Pearl Rhyne were married January 9, 2009. She survives in Perryville, MO.
