Photo Donald G. Lohmann was taken to his heavenly home on April 26 after a long period of ill health in southwest Florida. He was born in Perryville on February 9, 1940, the son of Walter and Ruth. He leaves his wife Jill (Giesler) of 58 years, a daughter Lorri Feldt (Robert), grandsons Thomas and Samuel and granddaughter Susan.

He also leaves his brother Gary (Marsha) and his sister Janice Hinduja (Jagdish). Many in-laws, nieces and nephews also mourn his passing.

He graduated from PHS in 1958 and enjoyed his time on the football field and basketball court and also excelled in the classroom. He did undergraduate work at St. Cloud State University and the University of Missouri earning a bachelor's degree and MBA from Northwestern University.

He retired from Household International as president of Household Commercial, having spent a 30 year career with the company. He served two terms as president of the Alumni Advisory Board of the Kellogg School of Management at Northwestern.

He loved his wife and family and doted on his grandchildren, bursting with pride at their many accomplishments. In retirement he loved spending time playing golf and tennis. In the nineties he became an active investor and dive

participant in the recovery of the Santa Margarita, a Spanish galleon which sank in the Marianas Islands in 1601. He was particularly proud of having located the anchor of the sunken ship.

He and Jill traveled widely and enjoyed wonderful times with family and friends. He lived a full life. And now he rests in peace.
