Donald O. Telle, 90, of Uniontown, passed away Sunday, March 6, 2022 at The Villas of Jackson Memory Care.

He was born March 17, 1931 in Uniontown, MO to Edwin A. and Agnes C. (Franke) Telle.

Donald was a life member of Grace Lutheran Church in Uniontown. He was baptized on March 22, 1931 at Grace Lutheran Church in Uniontown, MO. He was confirmed at Grace Lutheran church on April 3, 1944 and was a 1949 graduate of Perryville High School. He served in the United States Army in the Korean Conflict from 1952 to 1954.
