Dorene Orva Grebing, 89, of Perryville, Missouri passed away Thursday, September 16, 2021 at Perry County Memorial Hospital.

She was born February 28, 1932 in Seventy-Six, Missouri to Ernst and Meta (Bronenkant) Verseman.

She and Milton Grebing were married August 18, 1951 at Concordia Lutheran Church, Frohna. He preceded her in death November 5, 1986.

Dorene and Milton were grade A dairy farmers for many years with a peak herd of 135 cows. Dorene enjoyed gardening, sewing, canning and was a 4-H sewing leader for 35 years. She also delighted in singing in the church choir. She directed apple butter making and bread baking for many years at Saxon Lutheran Memorial Fall Festival. She wrote a weekly column about East Perry County for the Community Press and then later the SunTimes Newspaper.

Dorene was a member of Concordia Lutheran Church in Frohna. In addition to being a Perry County Extension Club president, she was also a member of the Frohna Extension Club, the Frohna Friendship Circle and Concordia Lutheran Ladies Aid. Her time working with the Missouri Community Betterment Committee led to state accolades and awards. Many family and friends benefited from her sewing, crocheting and quilting skills. Her signature

homemade items are now treasured keepsakes.
