Ellen L. Weinhold, 88, of Crosstown, Missouri died Wednesday, July 22, 2020 at Independence Care Center in Perryville, Missouri.

She was born February 10, 1932 in Cape Girardeau County, Missouri to Edwin and Laura (Aufdenberg) Fluegge.

She and Herbert Weinhold were married August 9, 1953. He preceded her in death on September 28, 2015.

She was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Crosstown, the Ladies Aid and previously served as church organist and Sunday school teacher.
