Elsie Edna (Gross) Sandlin, 88, of Perryville, MO died on October 11, 2016. She was born on May 28, 1928, at Menfro, MO the daughter of Edmund and Hilda (Tiedemann) Gross. On May 23, 1948, she married Willard J. Sandlin of Perryville, MO.

Elsie worked at the local shoe factory in Perryville for forty-three years before she retired.
