Emil E. Lohmann, 82, of Altenburg died June 5, 2014 at Independence Care Center in Perryville, MO.

He was born June 17, 1931 in Farrar, MO, son of Edwin and Lydia (Hadler) Lohmann. He and Caroline A. Lichtenegger were married July 26, 1953. She preceded him in death on December 28, 2002.

Mr. Lohmann was a farmer and a former Perry County Judge/Commissioner. He received the Outstanding Young Farmer Award in 1960. He was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church where he served as Treasurer, Elder, Sunday School teacher, Finance Board, and on various Building committees. He was active in the Lutheran Layman's League, Lion's Club, Golden Agers, Perry County Lutheran Historical Society and Lutheran Braille Workers.
