Floyd R. Klobe, 92, of St. Louis, MO died August 20, 2014 at MO Veterans Home in St. James, MO.

He was born April 16, 1922 in Sereno, MO, son of Emil John and Louise Mathilda (Schroeder) Klobe. He and Mary A. "Gussie" Bauer were married October 29, 1949. She preceded him in death on August 9, 2012.
