Fr. Walter J. Reisinger C.M., 91, of Perryville, Missouri passed away Saturday, November 14, 2020 at Apostle of Charity Residence at St. Mary of the Barrens in Perryville.

He was born February 4, 1929 in Saint Louis, Missouri to Nicholas and Reba (Burke) Reisinger.

He was a Roman Catholic Priest in the Congregation of the Mission, served as Associate and Pastor at St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church from 1972-1982. He taught high school math and science as well as college math and science. He was an outdoorsman.
