Joseph Franklin "Jack" Brewer was born October 10, 1935 on a farm in rural Brewer, Missouri, to Joseph Julian and Mamie Elizabeth (Franklin) Brewer. He died Sunday, November 15, 2015, in Owasso, Oklahoma, at the age of 80 years. Jack was reared and educated in Perryville, Missouri, and was a graduate of Perryville High School. He was a veteran of the armed forces having served with the United States Army during the Korean War. He was a member of the 82nd Airborne and was decorated with the National Defense Service Medal and Parachutist Badge. He was married July 10, 1954, in Fayetteville, North Carolina, to Velma Fadler.
