February 21, 1926 - January 25, 2013

Leo C. "Bud" Miget, 86, of Perryville, MO passed away January 25, 2013 at St. Francis Medical Center in Cape Girardeau. He was born on February 21, 1926 in Perry County, MO, son of Leo and Alice Alberta (Hager) Miget. He and Joan E. Havemann were married on December 1, 1951. She survives in Perryville, MO. Leo was a Band Director at St. Vincent Schools in Perryville and Valle Catholic Schools in Ste. Genevieve for 20 years. He was owner/operator of Miget Piano Service in Perryville where he was a piano tuner/technician, member of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church, US Navy WW II Veteran, Knights of Columbus Council 1263, American Legion Post 133 and National Piano Technician Guild. Leo graduated from St. Vincent High School in 1943 he then attended Southeast Missouri State University in Cape Girardeau for 1 ½ years, followed by Mid-Western Conservatory of Music in Chicago, IL where he earned a Bachelor's Degree in Music Theory and Composition. He then attended Northwestern University in Evanston, IL for 2 years and earned a Bachelor's Degree in Music Education. Bud was also a jazz pianist and a classical and jazz composer and arranger. Survivors include four daughters; Cynthia Davis of Vichy, Mo, Marcia Miget of San Rafael, CA, Susie Miget of West Des Moines, Iowa, Mary Ann "Mimi" Kinnison of Perryville, two sisters; Leola Laws and Lily Meyer both of Perryville, ten grandchildren and nine great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, four sisters; Luella Miget, Velda Gagnepain, Ruby Meyer and Marguerite "Pete" Young. Visitation will be held at Young & Sons Funeral Home on Monday, January 28 from 4:00 – 8:00 pm with a Catholic wake at 7:00 pm. Visitation will continue on Tuesday from 6:30 – 9:30 am with a rosary at 8:30 am. Funeral Mass will be held on Tuesday at St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church at 10:00 am with Rev.
