Lois M. Miesner, 88, of Glen Carbon, IL, formerly of Farrar, died June 9, 2017 at Mercy Hospital in Creve Coeur, MO.

She was born September 20, 1928 in Fort Wayne, Indiana, daughter of George H. and Frances A. (Lueders) Keen. She and Gilbert Paul "Gib" Miesner were married on February 3, 1951. He preceded her in death on December 7, 2010.
