Mary Margaret "Marge" Carron, 80, of Perryville died September 1, 2014 at Perry County Memorial Hospital in Perryville, MO.

She was born September 29, 1933 in Perryville, MO, daughter of Edward and Helen (Cissell) Hayden. She married Chauncey C. Carron on June 4, 1955, who survives in Perryville, MO.

Marge was a very loving and much loved wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. She graduated from St. Vincent High School in 1951. She graduated from De Paul Hospital School of Nursing in 1954 and worked at Perry County Memorial Hospital. In 1955, she married and moved to St. Louis with her husband who was attending St. Louis University Dental School. She then worked at St. Anthony's Hospital.
