Norma Emma Abernathy Sadler passed through this life on January 8, 2018, in Osage Beach, Missouri. Norma was born June 7, 1913, in Tilsit, Cape Girardeau County Missouri. She was the first of 8 children born to Duke E. and Marie L. (Sander) Abernathy. Two of her siblings survive: Frances Cromer (Cliff), Belton, Missouri and William Abernathy (Gerry), Sarasota, Florida. She married Dallas Sadler and together they had three children. There she taught for the Bureau of Indian Affairs in Pinon and followed that by teaching in and retiring from the Ganado Public School System in Arizona. After retirement she moved back to Missouri where she lived in Perryville, Columbia, Lees Summit and Osage Beach.
