Oliver Gene Bachmann, 90, of Perryville, Missouri passed away Thursday, October 3, 2024.

He was born May 4, 1934 in Crosstown, MO to Henry and Hedwig (Oster) Bachmann.

He graduated from PHS in 1952 and served in the US Army from January 1954 to December 1955. After training, he was deployed to Korea.

He and Alice Lydia Mangels were married at Salem Lutheran Church in Farrar, MO on June 7, 1958.
