Orville L. Schaefer, 86, of Perryville, died May 9, 2017 at his residence in Perryville, MO.

He was born November 23, 1930 in Uniontown, MO, son of Herman Benjamin and T. Onita (Popp) Schaefer. He and Laverne Steffens were married on August 20, 1955. She survives in Perryville, MO.

He was owner/operator of Schaefer Water Centers. He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church. He graduated from PHS class of 1949 and from University of Missouri – Rolla in 1958. He was a United States Army veteran of the Korean Conflict.

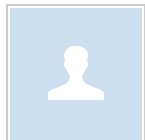
