Paul Russell "Butch" Flentge, 83, of Perryville died May 19, 2016 at his residence in Perryville, MO.

He was born June 24, 1932 in Perryville, MO, son of Harry and Emma (Schenck) Flentge. He and Marilyn J. Zoellner were married on March 31, 1951. She survives in Perryville.

Paul was a Milk and Ice Cream Distributor and Deliveryman from 1957 – 1986. He started and coached Minor League Baseball here in Perryville, he was a Sgt. in the National Guard, a Webelos Scout Leader, Explorer Scout Leader, Park Board Member, Alderman Ward 3 for 22 years, serving as Alderman when the Park Center was built and opened, Senior Citizens Board for 3 years, Charter member of the Sportsman Club, named Honorary member of Sportsman Club in January of 2015, Immanuel Lutheran Church, American Legion Post 133, and former V.F.W. Post 4282 .

He was preceded in death by his parents; one son, David M. Flentge; one granddaughter, Danielle Zoellner; one infant grandchild; three brothers; and four sisters.
