Paul H. Hoecke Jr, 82, of Perryville, died October 26, 2018 at his residence in Perryville, Missouri surrounded by his family.

He was born October 4, 1936 in Cape Girardeau, MO, son of Paul H. and Rosella “Sally” (Heisserer) Hoecke Sr. He and the love of his life, Donna M. Buchheit, were married on December 27, 1958. She survives in Perryville, MO.
