Paul B. "Doc" Schroeder, 89, of Perryville, Missouri passed away Saturday, August 21, 2021 at his residence in Perryville, MO.

He was born November 24, 1931 in Perryville, MO to William J. and Anna A. (Kirn) Schroeder. He and Diana K. Gegg were married November 5, 1966. She preceded him in death on September 22, 2018.

Doc's general nature was to fix things, which fed his curiosity of how things worked. He started out servicing TVs, which led to a job with "Guyot and Ernst" as an electrician.
