Ralph N. Wibbenmeyer, 92, of Perryville formerly of Old Appleton, MO, died February 18, 2018 at Independence Care Center in Perryville, MO.

He was born April 18, 1925, in Biehle, son of Hugo A. and Cecilia (Lappe) Wibbenmeyer.
