September 26, 1913 - October 30, 2016

Reeva M. Feltz, 103, of Perryville died October 30, 2016 at the Estates of Perry in Perryville, MO. She was born September 26, 1913 in Perry County, Mo., daughter of William F. & Zita (Thomure) Heck. She and Ivan H. Feltz were married on May 29, 1937. He preceded her in death on October 15, 1998. Reeva attended Perryville High School, graduating in 1931. After high school she worked at the International Shoe Company sewing double needle fancy stitching on cowboy boots and shoes. She taught in both public and parochial school systems in Perry County for 26 years; including four one room schools consisting of eight grades known as the Sim Layton School, the Killian School, the Hunt School, and later taught at McBride Public, St. Mary Catholic, St. Agnes in Bloomsdale, and St. Joseph in Apple Creek. She was a member St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church, Daughters of Charity, Daughters of Isabella, Western Catholic Union, and Knights of Columbus Auxiliary. Survivors include three daughters Gloria (Ray) Brown, Marlene Williams, and Connie (Roger) Bergman all of Perryville, two sisters Dorothy Gibbons of Redding Ca., Esther Johnson of East Moline, Il, seven grandchildren: Candy Brown-Migneco of St. Louis, Randy Brown of Joplin, Mo., Curtis Williams of Beaufort, S.C., April (Williams) Bachler, of Linn, Chad Williams of Perryville, Angela (Williams) Christisen of Perryville and Hannah Bergman of Washington D.C., eighteen great grandchildren and one great great-grandson.
