Roman A. Dobsch, 89, of Perryville, died Sunday, August 4, 2019 at Southeast Hospital in Cape Girardeau, MO.

He was born September 8, 1929 in Washington, MO to Ernest and Emily (Kuenzel) Dobsch.

He and Dolores Wunderlich were married February 4, 1956. She survives in Perryville.

Roman was a US Air Force Korean Veteran. He was a member of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church, Knights of Columbus, Optimist club and V.F.W. Post 4282. He worked at McDonnell Douglas where he wired the control sticks for the first six Gemini Space Capsules. Roman owned and operated three A & W Restaurants and two John Deere dealerships.
