Rose Mary Buchheit, 95, of Perryville, passed away peacefully Wednesday, May 27, 2020 at Independence Square Residential Care Center.

She was born in Perry County, MO on November 16, 1924 to James Frederick and Anna Frances (Zahner) Endres. On November 16, 1946, she married Joseph Buchheit. They spent 47 happy years together before his passing on September 21, 1993.
