January 11, 1945 - March 11, 2025

Thelma A. Nations, 80, of Perryville, Missouri peacefully passed away Tuesday, March 11, 2025 at her residence surrounded by her loving family.

She was born January 11, 1945 in Longtown, MO to Anton J. and Wilma M. (Unterreiner) Buchheit.

Thelma and Clarence Eugene Nations were married November 28, 1964 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Apple Creek, MO. They were blessed with sixty years of marriage. He survives her in Perryville.

She was a home maker and a secretary for Fr. Charles Rice at the National Shrine of the Association of the Miraculous Medal. Thelma was a seamstress for Perry County for many decades, making priest vestments, casket palls, formal attire, band uniforms for both high schools and more. She loved sewing and quilting. She made many quilts for the Seminary Picnic. She volunteered for her children's school activities for many years. Thelma loved going on road trips with her husband and spending time with family and friends. In a 2015 statewide contest in Marceline, MO, she was voted Missouri's Best Grandmother.

She was a member of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church and volunteer at the National Shrine of the Association of the Miraculous Medal in Perryville.

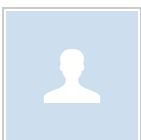
