Todd Lee Lohmann, 48 of Perryville passed away on December 15, 2018 while working on the family farm that he loved.

He was born on June 1, 1970 in Perryville, MO to Roy Lee and Virginia Ann (Baer) Lohmann. Todd was married to Cynthia (Gibbar) Lohmann on September 16, 1995. They were blessed with three beautiful daughters, Grace 18, Lydia 13 and Norah 10. Other survivors include three sisters, Tina Robinson, Vicki Lohmann and Jennifer (Paul) Fulmer, all of Perryville, one sister-in-law, Susan (Andy) Phimphavong of Houston, TX, seven nieces and nephews, Kersten, Josh, Haley and Cara Ann Fulmer, Alex and Abby Robinson and Ruth Phimphavong, and one great nephew, Jaxson Fulmer.

He was preceded in death by his paternal grandmother, Olivia (Weinrich) Lohmann, maternal grandfather, Henry Baer, paternal grandfather, Edmund Lohmann, maternal grandmother, Ethel (Hoffman) Baer and a niece, Shelby Lynn Fulmer.

Todd developed a life-long love of farming as a fifth generation Lohmann farmer. As a young boy he enjoyed spending time learning the trade from his grandpa and father and eventually took over the family farm operation for the last 10 years. Todd was farming 300 acres of the Lohmann farm as well as 700 additional acres. He was also involved in cattle farming. Todd and his family resided in the home built by his grandparents 50 years ago.

Todd was actively involved in the River Hills Antique Tractor Club, Perry County Extension Council and Vice President of the Perry County Soil and

Water Conservation District Board. He hosted SWCD Field Days, planted University of MO Extension Research Plots, chaperoned FFA National Convention trips twice with his daughter and was a dealer for Concept Agri-Tek. As an exceptional area farmer, he was chosen as the 2016 Conservation Farmer of the Year and in August 2017 he was presented with the MO State Fair Farm Family of the Year award. Todd was also an American Legion Booster. He was a member of St. Vincent de Paul Church and a 3rd degree Knight of Columbus.

Todd was known as a friendly, caring and compassionate person. He was willing to help anyone in need at any time, putting their needs above his own. He was a selfless and giving son, husband, father and brother. As his final act of kindness, he is donating his organs to help someone in need. When asked by others what he raised on his farm, Todd's answer was always, corn, wheat, beans and my girls. He will be sadly missed by many.

Visitation will be held at St. Vincent de Paul Catholic Church on Wednesday, December 19 from 4:00 to 8:00 pm and on Thursday, December 20 from 6:30 am until time of Mass at 10:00 am with Rev. Joe Geders C.M. officiating. Burial in the Mt. Hope Cemetery.
