Vernon Arthur Grebing, 88, of Frohna, died January 24, 2018 at St. Francis Medical Center in Cape Girardeau, MO.

He was born on December 8, 1929 in Frohna, MO, son of Charles and Anita (Metz) Grebing. He married Helen (Weinhold) on December 20, 1953. They were married for 64 years. She survives in Frohna.
