Viola Theiss, 90, formerly of Wittenberg, died March 1, 2014 at Independence Care Center of Perry County in Perryville, MO. She was born January 20, 1924, in Altenburg, MO, daughter of Rudolph and Dorothy (Mueller) Gerler. She and Gilbert Theiss were married December 26, 1942. He preceded her in death on October 6, 2006. Viola retired as Postmaster after 17 years at Wittenberg Post Office and 8 years at Frohna Post Office. She was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church, Ladies Aid and LWML of Altenburg, Altenburg Lion's Club, and NARFE Chapter 1237. She was a former member of St. Paul Lutheran Church, LWML, and church organist for 35 years in Wittenberg. Survivors include two daughters and one son, Kathy (Dan) Schoenherr of Frohna, Nancy Ponivas of Alton, IL, Gilbert A. Theiss of East Pointe, MI; eight grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents; husband; son-in-law, Lynn Ponivas; one brother, George Gerler; and one sister, Norma Engelhardt. Visitation will be held at Young & Sons East Perry Chapel in Altenburg on Friday, March 7 from 4:00 to 8:00 pm and on Saturday, March 8 from 6:30 to 8:30 am. She will then be taken to Trinity Lutheran Church in Altenburg for Service at 10:00 am with Rev. Steven Dressler officiating. Burial will be in the Church Cemetery.
