Willard C. Conrad, 91, of Perryville, died Tuesday, January 7, 2020 at Independence Care Center in Perryville, MO.

He was born April 7, 1928 in Sedgewickville to Lester and Hazel (Seabaugh) Conrad.

He and Dolores Conrad were married on October 4, 1947. She survives in Perryville.
