



## William Hartenbach C.M.

Fr. William E. Hartenbach C.M., 88, of Perryville, Missouri entered into eternal rest Friday, November 21, 2025 at Mercy Hospital Perry.

He was born October 13, 1937 in St. Louis, MO to William John and Dorothy Marie (Kubasch) Hartenbach.

Fr. William Hartenbach C.M. was a Roman Catholic Priest and member of the Congregation of the Mission. He entered the Novitiate at St. Mary's of the Barrens, Perryville on December 7, 1955. He professed vows at St. Mary's of the Barrens on December 8, 1960 and was ordained a Priest at St. Mary's of the Barrens, Perryville May 24, 1964. Fr. William Hartenbach C.M. served as Provincial of the Midwest Province for six years.

Survivors include sister, Nancy (Tom) McCue of Spring, TX; good friend, Cindy Goforth of Piedmont, MO.

He was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, James Hartenbach, Thomas Hartenbach.
